

The Peace Education Program License Agreement

1. This is a license agreement between The Prem Rawat Foundation (TPRF) and PEP Licensee (PL) as specified in an online Peace Education Program (PEP) License Application.
2. TPRF wishes to make PEP available to as many people as possible and appreciates PL's interest in helping to bring the PEP to people as indicated by PL's online Application for a License to conduct PEPs.
3. PL will be notified by email whether TPRF has approved this agreement. Immediately upon such notification of approval, TPRF grants PL:
 - a. The right to obtain PEP material from TPRF in whatever forms as TPRF may wish to make available, and via whatever means TPRF wishes to make available.
 - b. The right to conduct PEP courses for each Facility registered under this agreement. Courses may be presented to the constituents of each registered Facility: members, employees, citizens, students, inmates, as may apply to the Facility.
4. These rights are conveyed by TPRF without compensation (although TPRF welcomes contributions that support PEP and other activities of TPRF) in view of PL's agreement to assume the following obligations and abide by the following conditions:
 - a. All people who help to coordinate and facilitate the PEP will read and carefully and conscientiously observe the terms of this agreement.
 - b. All people participating in PEP will be treated with sensitivity, respect, and dignity in all interactions with them.
 - c. PEP Facilitators and others helping with the program will let the PEP materials speak for themselves and will not independently offer interpretations or explanations.
 - d. All PEP material, including but not limited to DVD's, videos, brochures, and online information, are copyrighted material belonging to TPRF. They are only to be used in the context of presenting the PEP and are not to be copied, loaned, distributed or displayed for any other purpose. According to copyright law, no changes to the material can be made, nor can the material be used in another context (including online distribution), without written permission from a TPRF official. No derivative works shall be created, including translations, and PL agrees that they have no possessory interest in the PEP materials. PL shall not upload any PEP materials to any online forum or group, social media platform or otherwise electronically available distribution system without the express permission of TPRF.
 - e. PL is authorized to use PEP material that is currently available on the PEP materials website. TPRF reserves the right to add or remove authorized material at any time. TPRF will promptly inform PL of any such changes. PL will utilize only currently authorized material, allowing for a reasonable transition period, for example, to complete a course in progress.

- f. People helping to offer or facilitate PEP will not present themselves as agents, employees, representatives, or spokespersons of TPRF.
 - g. Representatives of the media who approach PL and PL's associates with questions about TPRF or Prem Rawat must be referred to TPRF. TPRF reserves and retains the sole right to respond to media inquiries.
 - h. TPRF does not accept responsibility, liability, or a duty to defend against any claims of negligence or damages of any kind, including but not limited to data privacy issues, arising from PL's conducting of PEPs.
 - i. PL will comply with the PEP reporting requirements of TPRF as such requirements are defined online and as such requirements may be from time to time revised by TPRF.
 - j. PL will comply with the PEP training requirements of TPRF as such requirements are defined online and as such requirements may be from time to time revised by TPRF.
5. TPRF reserves the right to terminate this License at any time, for any reason. Any such termination will be effective immediately upon electronic notification of PL. Upon such termination, PL will immediately cease to offer or conduct PEP, and will, within 5 working days: (a) return all physical PEP materials to TPRF; (b) delete all digitally stored PEP materials from any and all digital storage devices; and (c) acknowledge the deletion of any such materials and the return of PEP materials, the reasonable shipping costs of which will be reimbursed to PL by TPRF.
